## Installation Instructions (Brick Or Rendered Wall).

- 1. Unwrap your print in an appropriate location. Preferably on a soft floor like carpet or a rug.
- 2. Take the loose MDF plate from within the packaging and set it aside.
- 3. Using a measuring tape, measure from the ceiling down to the point you want the top edge of the print to finish.
- 4. Let's say you want the top edge to finish 1200mm from the ceiling, and your print is 800mm high.
- 5. Measure down 1200mm from the ceiling and then a further 500mm which is the point the bottom edge of the hanging plate will finish.
- 6. Mark this point using a pencil.
- 7. Using a 6mm drill bit, drill two holes horizontally into the centre of the loose MDF hanging plate.
- 8. Place the MDF plate against the wall aligning the bottom edge with the pencil mark.
- 9. Level the hanging plate using a spirit level.
- 10. Using a pencil mark the location of the holes onto the wall surface.
- 11. Remove the plate and drill a 6mm hole into the wall.
- 12. Install the supplied wall fixings into the holes you have drilled.
- 13. Place the supplied screws through the holes in the hanging plate and then fix them into the fixings that are now in your wall.
- 14. Using a screw driver, secure the hanging plate to the wall, checking and adjusting it for level as you go.
- 15. Once you are happy the hanging plate is securely in place, take the glass print from the packaging.
- 16. Holding the print with a hand on each side (get a second person to help if necessary) lift the print up above the hanging you installed and slide the print down until the two hanging plates connect.
- 17. Once the hanging plates have connected release the print and check to ensure it's centred.
- 18. Move the print from left to right to suit.
- 19. Stand back and enjoy.

## **Installation Instructions (Gyprock Wall).**

- 1. Unwrap your print in an appropriate location. Preferably on a soft floor like carpet or a rug.
- 2. Take the loose MDF plate from within the packaging and set it aside.
- 3. Using a measuring tape, measure from the ceiling down to the point you want the top edge of the print to finish.
- 4. Let's say you want the top edge to finish 1200mm from the ceiling, and your print is 800mm high.
- 5. Measure down 1200mm from the ceiling and then a further 500mm which is the point the bottom edge of the hanging plate will finish.
- 6. Mark this point using a pencil.
- 7. Using a 6mm drill bit, drill two holes horizontally into the centre of the loose MDF hanging plate.
- 8. Place the MDF plate against the wall aligning the bottom edge with the pencil mark.
- 9. Level the hanging plate using a spirit level.
- 10. Using a pencil mark the location of the holes onto the wall surface.
- 11. Remove the plate and drill a 10mm hole into the Gyprock wall.
- 12. Install the supplied Gyprock wall fixings into the holes you have drilled.
- 13. Place the supplied screws through the holes in the hanging plate and then fix them into the fixings that are now in your wall.
- 14. Using a screw driver, secure the hanging plate to the wall, checking and adjusting it for level as you go.
- 15. Once you are happy the hanging plate is securely in place, take the glass print from the packaging.
- 16. Holding the print with a hand on each side (get a second person to help if necessary) lift the print up above the hanging you installed and slide the print down until the two hanging plates connect.
- 17. Once the hanging plates have connected release the print and check to ensure it's centred.
- 18. Move the print from left to right to suit.
- 19. Stand back and enjoy.
